



CARP ADP

DESCRIPTION:

Carp ADP is an acetone dried powder of Common carp (Cyprinus carpio) pituitaries. It is a crude preparation containing all the pituitary hormones and surplus proteins.

STORAGE:

Shelf-life--Powder: one year plus at room temperature if kept dessicated; longer if refrigerated.

Liquid: 4 days maximum. Must be refrigerated; better frozen and thaw just before use.

ASSAY:

Carp ADP contains 10 to 15 mg GTH per gram of powder.

SHIPPING:

Carp ADP is provided in glass vials.

USES:

Carp ADP is the most economical source of carp gonadotropic hormone (GTH) for large scale induced ovulation programs. Carp ADP has been shown to reduce time to sexual maturation; systematize seed production; reduce labour time to strip in cultivation programs.
